



NOTICE OF RACE
Lake Pend Oreille Yacht Club
Bayview, Idaho
May 25–26, 2019

1. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- The regatta is open to all boats eligible to race under PHRF rules and regulations.
- Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form found at LPOYC.org by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 24th.



2. CLASSIFICATION:

- Boats shall be ranked by PHRF, lowest to highest, then split into roughly equal fleets based on number of entries received. The race committee shall attempt to create fleets with at least five, and no more than 10, boats in each fleet.
- One-design classes, with a least five (5) entrants, will receive their own start and compete independently from other classes. One-design classes, with less than five (5) entrants, may have their own start by paying combined registrations of \$250.00.
- Boats under 20’ will sail with the non-spinnaker fleet and will be eligible for their own recognition!

3. RULES:

- The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017–2020*, this Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions, rules and regulations of PHRF and PHRF Northwest, if sailing in a one-design fleet – applicable class rules, and any amendments made at a Skipper’s Meeting.

4. FEES:

- Registration fee is \$50.00 per entry, which does not include t-shirts.
- T-shirts – Will only be sold online through the LPOYC website. Styles and prices vary. Allow 8-10 days for delivery by mail.
- Meal ticket – There will be a gathering after the races at the Captain’s Wheel Resort. Rather than prepaid tickets, there will be drink specials and a full menu available to suit anyone’s taste. Refreshments will be provided at the Skipper’s meetings. Check out the menu at **The Captain’s Wheel Resort** on Facebook.

5. SCHEDULE:

6. NUMBER OF RACES:

- The number of races and scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race will be announced at the skippers meeting preceding the race. When there has been a long postponement and when more than one race (or sequence of races, for two or more classes) will be held on the same day, the warning signal for the first race and each succeeding race will be made as soon as practicable.
- One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta. When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores. When six races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores, less one throw-out. If eight or more races are completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores, less two throw-outs.

7. PRIZES:

- Prizes will be awarded to the top three places in each fleet.

8. INSURANCE:

- Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$100,000. Insurance Company and Policy number must be included on the registration form.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

- Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10. BERTHING:

- Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in their designated marina. A listing of available moorage and location contacts is included below. Boat owners are responsible for making their own arrangements. *Memorial Day is a busy time in Bayview, so call early and make your reservations.*
